#### **RULES and Regulations**

Nominations will not be considered until date of closure, entries will be considered at the discretion of the committee & preference will be given to those who are active, working committee members of all clubs. No late entries will be accepted.

Eight first round starts, applies to all competitors.

Scratching's: Rule D.5; 7 days prior to 8am of draft (return 100%); then can keep \$15; then 4 days prior to 8a, of draft (Keep 100%)

**Juvenile**: Riders to be 13yrs - under 17yrs. Limit of 2 horses. Juvenile riders are not permitted to also ride in open age events

**Junior**: Riders to be 8yrs - under 13yrs. Limit of 2 horses. Junior riders are not permitted to also ride in open age events

**Working Stock Horse**: The following events will be run: Open-W3, Maiden-W3(no Whip), Junior/Juvenile-W1. These events are dual affiliated with ASHS, thus ASHS membership numbers are not required.

**Helmets:** must be worn by ALL competitors under the age of 18yrs whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

Prize money: As per Rule R.9 & R.7

**RULE 9.4:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of the horse participating.

Stallions: Stallions will be allowed to be unrestrained in panel yards through day light hours ONLY. Only 1 horse is allowed per enclosure. Stallions must be double tied at night time. Panels must be a minimum of 1500mm in height. Panels must be constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of 25mm box/pipe equivalent as a minimum. Panels must be anchored securely to a sold object i.e. truck, post. Juniors and Juveniles are not permitted to ride/handle stallions at any time. Electric tape perimeter is also to be erected. See rule 11.12

Strictly no dogs: on the grounds, you will be asked to leave or place the dog elsewhere.

The grounds will be open Thursday afternoon and will close on Monday.

Please do not build horse yards around trees or cross-country jumps. No manure to be left around trees or under jumps please.

Competitors to be neat and presentable at all times – Collared buttoned shirts (no t-shirts), boots, jeans/jodhpurs and hats or hard hats (no caps) will be allowed in competition
